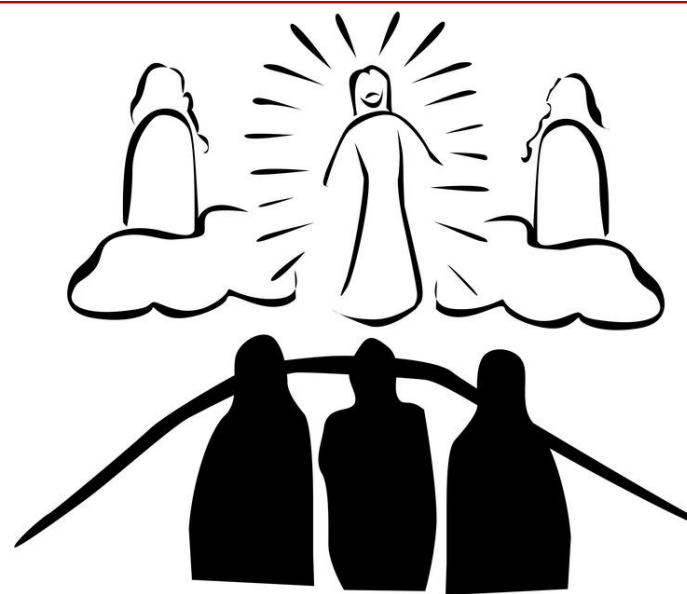

We are familiar with the possibility of seeing movies in trailer form before we see the actual movie itself. The trailer is a sneak preview to whet the appetite, so to speak.

Today as we celebrate the Transfiguration of the Lord, we get a preview of what heaven will be like. The voice from heaven brings the readings to a climax : in Jesus we are a beloved daughter or son to God and God is pleased with us.

It is the same message as in the second reading from Peter and that is repeated from Jesus' baptism, but there is the added reminder to *listen to him*.

The bright light and shining garments point back to the first reading and the description of the One sitting on the throne in the vision of Daniel. Jesus in dialogue with Moses and Elijah places him squarely in the line of the Law and the Prophets.

There is a link with the Passion too, in that the three disciples whom Jesus took to the mountain are the same whom he called with him into Gethsemane.

When we get our little passing glimpse of glory we are transformed, as were the disciples and like them, we 'lift up our eyes and see no one but Jesus only'.
