THE UNCONDITIONAL LOVE OF JESUS

Many passages in the Scriptures remind us that Jesus' death challenges us to leave sin behind.

For our sake he made the sinless one a victim for sin, so that in him we might become the uprightness of God. (2 Cor 5:21)

He was bearing our sins in his body on the cross, so that we might die to our sins and live for uprightness; through his bruises you have been healed. (1 Peter 2:24)

Meditating on Jesus' Passion moves to repent of our sins, to turn our backs on sin and walk from the cross as new people.
