If possible, guests are asked to bring their own bed-linen and towels. Doonas, blankets and pillows are available.

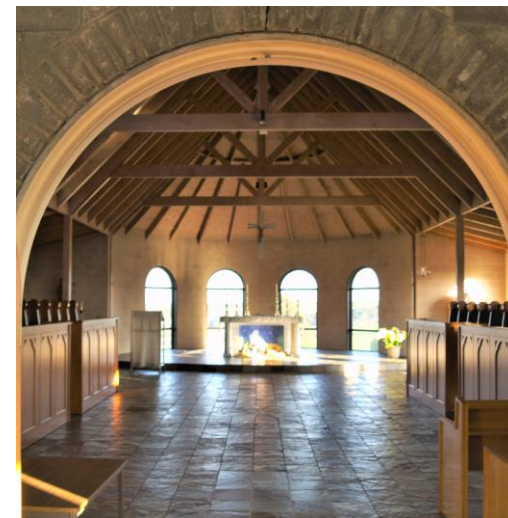
Guesthouses are not a commercial enterprise and reflect the monastic tradition of simplicity and quietness.
